Leadership

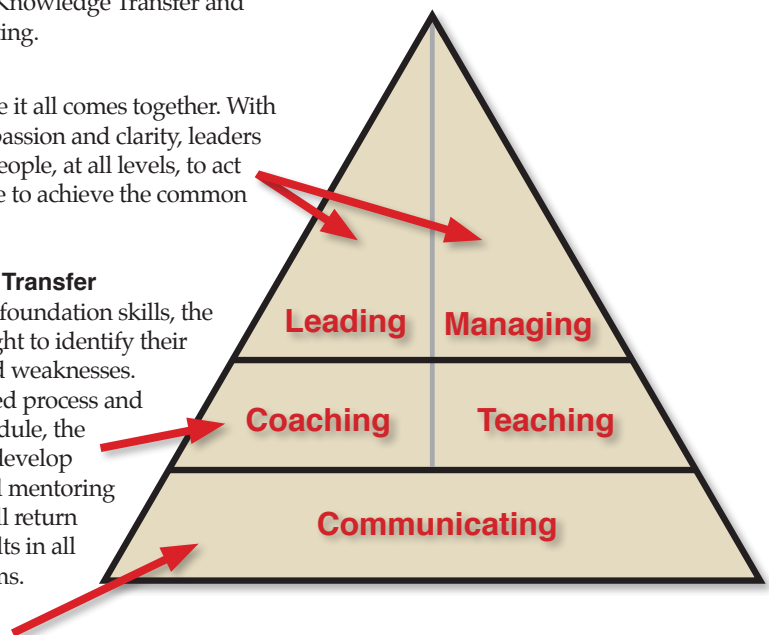
Here is where it all comes together. With confidence, passion and clarity, leaders can inspire people, at all levels, to act in accordance to achieve the common objectives.
